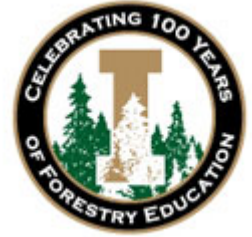

Part 1: What We Measure

The objectives of this laboratory exercise are to:

- Recognize several plant species that you will commonly encounter in forestry
- Become familiar with the Blodgett Track outdoor teaching forest
- Be familiar with the scientific names and the 4-letter codes of common plant species
- Learn good data recording practices

Location: Meet at **gold gravel parking lot**, beside power plant at 1:15pm
We will drive to Blodgett Track (20 minute drive) in 3 vehicles.

Materials and Supplies:

- Hard Hat (must be worn at all times)
- Clipboard
- Pencils

Exercise:

For each species you are introduced to write down the 4 letter species code and collect a sample. With each sample, write down the common name and it's the scientific name.

We highlight recommend you collect samples as we will quiz you on your ability to identify these species next week.
